Athens Sightseeing

After breakfast, we travel directly to the center of Athens to start our half day panoramic city tour. This tour giving you an opportunity to observe the striking contrasts that make Athens such a fascinating city.

Our expert guides will take you to see the Panathenaic Stadium where the first Olympic Games of modern times were held in 1896 (short stop). Continue and pass by the Temple of Olympian Zeus, the Hadrian's Arch, the Parliament and the memorial to the Unknown Soldier, the Academy, the University, the National Library, the Constitution Square (Syntagma).

On the Acropolis visit the Architectural Masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens: The Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike, the Erechtheion and finally "the harmony between material and spirit", the monument that "puts order in the mind", the Parthenon.

Avoid and skip the lines of the new museum of Acropolis, main attractions such as votives, artifacts of everyday life, statues from archaic period, Caryatids, and of course the Parthenon hall with the metopes. After the visit, free time at leisure in the traditional neighborhood of Plaka.

Crete, Chania, & Rethymno

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. On this full day tour you will have the chance to see the other 2 big cities of Crete which are Rethymno and Chania as well as the only natural lake of Crete the Kournas lake. Our first stop will be Rethymnon which is a graphic Cretan town, so characteristic and unique, that nothing similar is met anywhere else on the island of Crete. Rethymno is a romantic city with more of a provincial air and a place one falls in love at first sight. Visitors are able to feel the positive vibes of the city from the very first moment, making them feel at home. We will have time to relax at the beautiful scenery at the old port of Rethymnon.

Our second stop will be the old town of Chania which comes second in size on the island and is the sixth biggest city in Greece having approximately 100.000 residents. Its Venetian walls and harbor, narrow streets, and old buildings from the Venetian and Turkish period are mostly intact and take you directly to the past. The old harbor, where the small fishing boats can moor, is a perfect place to enjoy a coffee, have your lunch and observe the liveliness of the city. It's a great place for shopping too.

During our return to Heraklion we will have a short stop at the lake of Kournas. Lake Kournas is the only natural sweet water lake in Chania. For those who want, there is a possibility to make a tour in the lake on pedals, or just walk around the lake and swim. Lunch at local restaurant during the tour is included.

Crete, Knossos Palace, & Greek Olive Oil Tasting, Athens

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Today let's discover together the dawn of European Civilization and explore the Minoans in their homeland, Crete. The rise of the Minoans dates back in the 3rd millennium BC and within 2000 years time-span they offered to humanity incredible pieces of art. The mighty kingdom of the Minoans was controlled through the impressive 'palaces', the largest and most luxurious of all being Knossos, related to incredible myths like Minotaur, the Labyrinth and Ariadne's thread! The magnificent Minoan Palace of Knossos is perched up on the hill of Kephala, overlooking a fragrant pine-forested valley. The capital of the Minoan civilization was the first civilization in Europe, and also one of the most advanced in the ancient world.

We continue with a visit at a family-run olive oil mill set on the gently rolling hillsides in the outskirts of Heraklion. The Cretan Mill is a family estate in the Protected Designation of Origin Archanes. Surrounded by olive groves this ecological prototype farm promotes the traditional way of organic olive oil production – the olive oil is stone milled and cold pressed. They produce the oils exclusively from their olive groves. Enjoy a seated tasting of 3 extra virgin olive oils with 2 flavored oils, table olives, Cretan sweet vinegar and petimezi with water and bread!

We continue our exploration to the Midland of Crete. Archanes is a small vibrant town with meticulously restored old houses and pleasant squares a truly remarkable job has been done here. An agricultural town with a long history of 5000 years and important archaeological sites, while excavations conducted in the last 50 years have brought to li ght a lot of sites dating back to the Minoan period. Archanes Village is surrounded by endless vineyards and cool springs and the town itself is full of colorful houses, and vibrant flowers that decorate the yards and the streets.

Transfer to the airport and flight to Athens. Upon arrival transfer to the hotel.
